23 NUMBER OF ENTRIES PER ASSOCIATION		According to the 2018 ITTF World Tour Directives and SSI, we have to limit the number of entries to 410 players in total. Only the final entries are taken into consideration by the organizers and the Competition Manager for the participation of your players. Full details about entries' numbers can be found in the 2018 WT Directives and SSI but in general for the ITTF World Tour an association can enter a maximum of: Men and Women Singles: 6 players per Association (each gender) / 12 players for the Host Association (each gender) Men and Women Doubles: 2 pairs or 4 players per Association (each gender) / 3 pairs or 6 players for the Host Association (each gender) Mixed Doubles: 1 pair per Association / 1 pair for the Host Association U21 Men and Women Singles: 4 players per Association (each gender) Entries in singles and doubles will be approved based on the final number of entries and excess entries will be put on a waiting list. In case of extremely high number of entries the ITTF reserves the right to approve less entries than the maximum numbers above.
