Playing System:

Each event will be played in two stages.

1st stage: qualification group matches, round-robin system with groups of 4 or 5 players.

2nd stage: main draw with knock-out system.

All the matches will be played best of five games.

Facility:

The Club Arena Sport Centre one of the most important table tennis complex in Hungary, part of the ETTU's Network of European Training Centres. The playing-hall have official sport flooring, Taraflex. The competition will be held on 12 tables.

Overall point competition:

In the overall point competition all points gained in the events will be registered. Points: 1st place: 24 points; 2nd place: 18 points; 3rd place: 12 points; 5–8th place: 6 points; 9–16th place: 2 points

Awards:

In all events the top 4 players will receive medals. The winners will also receive a trophy. Based on the overall point competition the most successful delegation will receive the Cup of Hopes.
